BODY IMAGES The Tria Gallery presents "Bodies and Soul," a collection of works inspired by the relationship between one's inner and outer selves. Among the five artists represented in the show is Katheryn Holt, who makes art about familial bonds, employing layers of text, drawings, collage, and silk-screen images. Her painting "Rules of the Game" (2004), above, combines paper cutouts with various media. Other artists in the show are Michela Martello, who infuses her paintings with Eastern elements; a sculptor, Kathy Stecko; a stop-motion animator and sculptor, Ellen Nora Goldstein, and a contemporary realist painter, Josh George.
